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Basic Dial-Up Setup Information

1. From the desktop, click the **Start** button. Go to **Settings**, then **Network and Dial-up Connections**. Double-click **Make New Connection**. Click **Next**.
2. Select the radio button for **Dial-up to the Internet**. Click **Next**.
3. Select the radio button for **I want to set up my Internet connection manually...** Click **Next**.
4. For **How do you connect...?** Select **I connect through a phone line...** Click **Next**.
5. For **Telephone number:** enter 964-9999 or 865-3483 (for Timberlake customers). Click **Next**.
6. Click the **Advanced...** button. On the **Connection** tab, under **Connection Type**, select **PPP (Point to Point Protocol)** and under **Logon Procedure**, select **None**. Click **OK** and **Next**.
7. For **User name:** enter your **User ID** and then your **Password**. Click **Next**.
8. For **Connection name:** enter **Lakota Network**. Click **Next**.
9. For **Do you want to set up an Internet mail...?** Select **No**. Click **Next**.
10. Uncheck the box for **To connect to the Internet immediately...** Click **Finish**.
11. Alternate click (right click) on the **Lakota Network** icon. Select **Properties**.
12. Click on the **Networking** tab. Ensure **Internet Protocol (TCP/IP)** is highlighted, then click on the **Properties** button.
13. Ensure **Obtain an IP address automatically** radio button is selected.
14. Ensure **Obtain DNS server address automatically** radio button is selected.
15. Click **OK** until all dialog boxes are closed.

Basic E-mail Setup Information

1. From the desktop, double-click on **Outlook Express** and select **Tools** from the main menu.
2. From the **Tools** drop menu, select **Accounts**. Select the **Mail** tab and click and **Add** then select **Mail**. This will open a wizard with the following:
  - a. For **Display name:** enter your name:  
example (John Doe). Click **Next**.
  - b. Select **I already have an e-mail address...** Click **Next**.
  - c. Ensure **POP3** for the incoming mail server is selected and enter the following: Incoming Mail Server: **pop.lakotanetwork.com**  
Outgoing Mail Server: **mail.lakotanetwork.com** Click **Next**.
  - d. For **User name:** enter your **User ID** and then enter your **Password**. Click **Next**.
  - f. For **Connection name:** enter **Lakota Network**. Click **Finish**.
