Basic Dial-Up Setup Information

1. From the desktop, click the **Start** button. Go to **Programs, Accessories, Communications**, and then **Dial-Up Networking**.
2. Double-click on **Make New Connection** and type in **Lakota Network**. Click **Next**.
3. For the phone number, enter 964-9999 or 865-3483 (for Timberlake customers), click **Next** and **Finish**.
4. Alternate click (right click) on the **Lakota Network** icon. From the drop menu, select **Properties**.
5. Select the **Networking** tab. Ensure **PPP: Internet, Windows 2000/NT, Windows Me** is selected.
6. Move down to **Allowed Network Protocols:** and deselect all but **TCP/IP**. Click on the **TCP/IP Settings...** button.
7. Ensure the **Server Assigned IP Address** radio button is selected.
8. Ensure **Server assigned name server addresses** radio button is selected.
9. Click **OK** until all dialog boxes are closed.

Basic E-mail Setup Information

1. From the desktop, double-click on **Outlook Express** and select **Tools** from the main menu.
2. From the **Tools** drop menu, select **Accounts**. Select the **Mail** tab and click **Add** then select **Mail**. This will open a wizard with the following:
  - a. Ensure the **I already have an e-mail** radio button is selected.  
For **Display name:** (enter your name)  
example (John Doe). Click **Next**.
  - b. For **E-mail address:** enter your e-mail address in the following format:  
example (userid@lakotanetwork.com). Click **Next**.
  - c. Ensure **POP3** for the incoming mail server is selected and enter the following:  
Incoming Mail Server: **pop.lakotanetwork.com**  
Outgoing Mail Server: **mail.lakotanetwork.com**
  - d. For **Account name:** enter your **User ID** and then the **password**. Click **Next** and **Finish**.
  - e. Double-click on **pop.lakotanetwork.com** and choose a name of your choice for your account.  
example: (John Doe's Mail). Click **Apply** then **Ok**.
